Subject: Upcoming ONC SVAP Standards Update – SMART App Launch v2.2.0 and Bulk Data Access v2.0.0

Dear Valued Customer,

As part of our ongoing commitment to interoperability, regulatory compliance, and industry best practices, we are updating our healthcare platform to support the latest standards approved through the Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC) Standards Version Advancement Process (SVAP).

Standards Being Updated

Effective with our upcoming software release, the following interoperability standards will be updated:

Standard	Previous Version	New Version
SMART Application Launch Framework	v2.0.0	v2.2.0
FHIR Bulk Data Access (Flat FHIR Export)	v1.0.1	V2.0.0

What This Means

These updates improve interoperability, security, and compatibility with certified health IT systems while aligning with current ONC SVAP-approved standards.

SMART App Launch v2.2.0

The updated SMART App Launch specification includes enhancements designed to improve:

- Authorization and authentication workflows
- Security and OAuth 2.0/OpenID Connect support
- SMART application compatibility
- Implementation consistency across EHR platforms

These enhancements enable more secure and reliable integration between SMART-enabled applications and our platform.

Bulk Data Access v2.0.0

The updated Bulk Data Access implementation provides improvements including:

- Updated asynchronous export capabilities

- Enhanced support for population-level data exchange
- Improved performance and scalability
- Better alignment with the latest HL7 FHIR Bulk Data specification

Organizations utilizing Bulk Data exports for analytics, reporting, population health, or payer exchange should experience improved interoperability and future compatibility.

Existing functionality will continue to operate normally, and these updates are designed to be backward compatible wherever possible.

Customers who have developed custom integrations or SMART applications should review their implementations to ensure compatibility with the updated specifications.
